New hourly rate

On September 1, the MacAtoZ standard rate changed to \$84 per hour.

This was the first rate increase since mid-2006, and, as you might

have guessed, came in response to the broad inflationary pressure

in the overall economy and the cost increases MacAtoZ has incurred as part of doing business. Put simply: It is costing substantially more to provide the quality of service you deserve.

That said, it's worth remembering that MacAtoZ remains much less expensive than bringing out someone from, say, the Mac Store (\$114 for the first hour there). Plus we're members of the Apple Consultants Network and Help Desk Certified by Apple. MacAtoZ

MacAtoZ Service Suite Tier 2 and Tier 3 members can now log into their web sites via SFTP or ssh. In fact, if you transfer files to your web space (2 GB for Tier 2; 12 GB for Tier 3) via FTP we strongly recommend that you change to either SFTP or ssh for security
